Information about the Mauritanian National Gendarmerie

Bureau des Ressources Humaines (Office of Human Resources). Responsible for management, accounting and mobilization of personnel. In addition, it is responsible for the reception, recording, distribution and preparation of the mail.

Bureau d'Analyse et de Coordination (Office of Analysis and Coordination). This office is responsible for centralizing all information.

Bureau Operations, Instruction et Emploi (Office Operations, Training and Employment). This office is primarily responsible for education and training of personnel. It develops programs, ensure military preparedness and proposes in this context the necessary adjustments and amendments. It establishes and oversees the preparation of defense plans and protection units of the gendarmerie and maintains collaboration with the different units files of sensitive points.

Bureau Casernement (Barracks Office). This office is responsible for all matters related to logistics and the implementation of engineering elements.

Bureau Central de Recherche (Central Research Bureau). Responsible for the judicial police; it centralizes assets as personnel, vehicles, weapons and items that are requested by the territorial units of the gendarmerie, police services, justice, armed forces and other public and private institutions. It also handles the control of documents and immigration managent.

Bureau d'Etudes et Relations Publiques (Office of Studies and Public Relations). Responsible for documentation, information and public relations.

Centre Administratif de la Gendarmerie Nationale (Administrative Centre of the National Gendarmerie). The administrative center of the National Gendarmerie's main mission is to provide the financial resources necessary for the functioning of the Institution.

Direction des Services Techniques (Directorate of Technical Services). Responsible for the technical needs of the gendarmerie like transport, telecommunications, computers, weapons, ammunition and various accessories.

Escadron Hors Rangs (Squadron with multiple tasks). Responsible for security of the barracks and the staff offices; guidance, monitoring and transition staff on secondment. It is a reserve for the units engaged in the maintenance of order. Other units are:

- I. La Gendarmerie Départementale (Departmental Police). This is a subdivision of the national police that coordinates the territorial units responsible for planning, intelligence gathering and execution of administrative police missions, judicial and military. It participates in maintaining order.
- II. La Gendarmerie Mobile (Mobile Gendarmerie). This is a subdivision of the National Gendarmerie, mainly intended to ensure the maintenance and restoration of order.
- III. La Gendarmerie Specialisée (Specialized Gendarmerie). In addition to the provincial gendarmerie and the mobile gendarmerie, the national police has several specialized units including:
 - a. Le Groupe d'Escadrons d'Escorte et de Sécurité (Squadrons Escort and Security Group)
 - b. La Compagnie de Gendarmerie des Transports Aériens (Gendarmerie Air Transport Company)
 - c. Groupe de Sécurité et d'Intervention de la Gendarmerie Nationale (Security and Intervention Group of the National Gendarmerie)
 - d. Les Brigades Maritimes et Fluviales (Maritime and River Brigades)
 - e. Les Brigades de Recherches Judiciaires (Judicial Research Brigade)
 - f. Le Groupe Cynophile (Canine Group)
 - g. La Brigade Douanière (Customs Brigade)
- IV. Ecole de Gendarmerie de Rosso (Gendarmerie School, Rosso). The school is responsible for the training of students and police cadets, and retraining of personnel.
